The BMT Federation

The BMT Federation is a not-for-profit organisation whose aim is to encourage and recognise the use of behavioural science to make positive changes in the world.

Practitioner accreditation

We offer accreditation for individuals who are successfully using behavioural science to improve business performance. Those who achieve BMT practitioner accreditation receive a BMT Federation accreditation certificate and are listed on the BMT Federation website.

Who can apply?

Any individual who has delivered behavioural improvements in business in the last two years can apply for accreditation. Applicants will need to demonstrate behavioural knowledge and implementation of the techniques.

The application process

The application process consists of the submission of a short portfolio of evidence and is carried out electronically, with all required information being transferred electronically:

Online knowledge test – This section tests basic knowledge on the subject matter. Applicants must achieve a minimum pass rate of 75% and are allowed a maximum of three attempts.

Achieving business change – This section gives applicants the opportunity to showcase the business improvements they have supported their course delegates to deliver. Applicants are expected to provide evidence of three different improvements that they have implemented in the workplace to deliver measurable improvement.



Accreditation fees

The fees for each practitioner are £150 (excl. VAT) for the initial accreditation.
